- Short, formless letter in English to the chairman of the Doctorates Committee asking for acceptance (currently Prof. Dr. Markus Kreutzer)
- **"Promise of Doctoral Supervision" as confirmation of acceptance by an EBS Senior Professor**
- Proof of having a very good command of the English language, by providing
 - a certificate of a completed, English-language degree program, such as Bachelor
 - or an official report of an acknowledged test (e.g. TOEFL IBT with a minimum score of 100, or IELTS (academic) score with a minimum of 7.5 points)
 - or a certificate (min. Level of C1)
- If required by your supervisor a proof of an official report of the Graduate Management admission Test (GMAT) with the achievement of the predefined number of points by the first supervisor.
- Curriculum vitae in tabular form
- Abitur certificate
- Degree certificate(s) with transcripts: (the final grading of the highest degree must be a "good" as minimum grading)
- The following statement dated and signed by the applicant: "I declare upon my word of honour that I have never unsuccessfully attempted a doctoral degree at another university"
- Ethical guidelines for doctoral studies (signed by the applicant)

And finally, you have to add to the documents

A written Research Proposal in English (approx. 3 pages)
